As part of the culminating task for placement. The individual College Program may ask you to complete a student placement evaluation. Here are some things you can consider when evaluating a student during and after they have successfully completed placement at your agency.

Can the student:

- demonstrate that learning outcomes were achieved
- understand their roles and responsibilities
- use the necessary software or supports to effectively complete their daily responsibilities
- present themselves in a professional manner to colleagues and clients at all times
- communicate effectively both oral and written and use necessary software to enhance communication efforts
- work independently and/or within a team as necessary
- work in a safe manner and support the safety of others
- demonstrate initiative
- take constructive criticism
- demonstrate attendance is timely and reliable
