



SAFETY TRAINING FOR STUDENTS

Mandatory College Training

At the college we take safety seriously. All students are required to complete the following training modules prior to commencing their Placement

1. AODA – Customer Service Standards
2. IASR – Training on the Human Rights Code
3. Bill 168 – Workplace Violence and Harassment (Employee Training)
4. WHMIS 1988
5. WHMIS 2015
6. Occupational Health And Safety Awareness Training for Workers

As a Placement Agency, you can request copies of these certificates for your own records.

Additional Training

In the instance where your Agency requires the student be trained in additional areas, outside the ones listed above then you should ensure students are trained appropriately. Examples of these additional training areas can include:

- Any additional Placement Agency training that is mandatory and not already insured by the College. These should be completed prior to commencing placement.
- If lifting is required ensure student is trained in the proper procedure.
- CPR/First Aid Certification training.
- Ensure students are aware of their option with regards to harassment/discrimination protocols within the Placement Agency;
- Placement Agency Fire Procedures;
- Routine Precautions and Infection control training (provided free by Public Health);
- Ensure Students have appropriate safety equipment required for placement, i.e. respirators (masks) or safety goggles;

- Students are aware of Emergency Codes, Emergency contacts (e.g. security issues, medical issues);
- Students are trained on specific pieces of equipment they will be using;
- Students are aware of Lockdown procedures, security processes; and
- Incoming orientation is provided by the agency.
